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Faith Outreaches

In our collective, the term "Faith Ostreach' is used to describe times when we put everything down and leave where we are staying (whether a momey van, or shand commodation) for a period of time, stretching from as little as a few daws to a few weeks, and sometimes for a month or more. Often we head off with just the clothes on our backs and possibly a few items in a backpack (e.g. a blik, nothbrash, pentalis ec). On other cocasions it has included linking a tent or sleeping bug, and possibly some trues to distribute. Faith Ostreaches can be in unbest or rural settings, and sometimes they can include a mixture of both.

So, in these people's minds, there is no need to prepare for this eventually. It doesn't take much to see that this belief is based more on wishful thinking than on sound doctrine. A lot of professing Christians loday don't want in consider that God may allow them to be put in a situation where they will actually suffer for their faith. This has led to the Charch denying that we will go through the predicted 'Great Tribulation' because of a verse that says we are "spared from wrath" However, it is worth pointing out that there is a big diffe between a time of testing for all (the 'Great Tribulation')

Jesus said we can't serve two masters (God or money) and that we have to make a clear choice about which one we will work for (Matthew 6:24). He directed us to "sock first the kingdom of God and all its rightecosness", making it clear that if we do, our basic needs of food and clothing would be mat it we do, our basis needs of roots and citothing would be met on a daily basis. We are teed not to worry about tomor-row (Matthew 6:34); that we should pick up our cross daily (Luke 9:23); and that we should just ask for our "daily bread" (Matthew 6:11) In effect, we are being taught to live hand-to-mouth in complete dependency on God.

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It is understood from scripture that the period of Vireat Tribu-lation's in marked by 7 trumpets and Poul stops in 1 Theosolo-mians 4-16 that the rapture occurs with the *Irrumpted Color. In light of this, we believe that Faith Outreaches are helpful in bringing into sharper focus the reality of God's supernatural provision, when we choose to step out in faith and seek to serve other popels. but they are also a form of necessary preparation for what is destined to come, quite possibly in our own lifetime.

If we are serious about not wanting to get micro-chipped in future, we are probably just kidding ourselves if we are not willing to take the necessary steps to learn to live without money about of time. This is worth praying about further when considering whether to experiment with Faith Out-

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Why Go on a Faith Outreach?

There are many reasons for going on a Faith Outreach, but the primary reasons is to experience God's Kingdom and to share this with others, while trusting that our basic needs (food, coloning, shelter ecc), will be looked after, usually without us knowing how this will be the case (hence the faith part!).

If we have doubts as to whether 'God' may be little more than a theological construct, then stepping out in faith, away from familiar surroundings and comforts, can be a great way to shatter this misconception, as long as we remain genuinely open to being proved wrong.

The beauty of the Seek-First-Thi-Kingdom principle is that helping and loving others is its own intrinsic reward. We are given immense satisfaction from seeing people's lives touched when we choose to help them out, without thought of petting semething in return from them. And the additional reward is that we usually find our own needs get locked after as well.

This has taken the form of not using money at all (even if we find it, or someone offers it to us) or not asking people for help ecc.

On a recent Faith Outreach we received the words "open formula" in a prayer time, after we had started out with a more hard-line approach.

This prompted us to relax our approach which led to us experimenting with things like hith-thicking. Which approach to take may depend on the level of faith and experience of the people taking part, but not always.
